



CACHE Level 2 Certificate in an Introduction to Early Years Education and Care

What does this course involve?

- It is a one year course which involves spending 3 days in the Sixth Form learning about different aspects of child care and 2 days at a local nursery or primary school to gain practical experience.
- All students must have a clear Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check prior to starting the course.

What are the entry requirements?

- At least 5 grade D - E's or a Pass on a Foundation course. Must include English and Maths grade D-E's

What is the structure of the qualification?

- The qualification consists of a number of mandatory and optional units



How is the course graded?

- The course is graded Pass or Refer

What courses or employment can I progress to at the end of my course?

- On successful completion of this course you could progress onto CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Childcare and Education.
- You could gain employment in a nursery or primary school with 'assistant practitioner' status. Therefore you would be supervised at all times
