









Certificate of Personal Effectiveness – CoPE Level 3

CoPE is a qualification that develops skills that are not only vital for success in CoPE, but will also help your performance in other subjects.

CoPE is a 100% coursework based qualification and is assessed by creating a portfolio of evidence – It is equivalent to 70 UCAS points (A at AS Level)
