# A Level and AS Level Music

This Edexcel course is for anyone who has a keen interest in creating, listening to and performing different styles of music.

On the course you will complete stud composing, performing, listening and critical analysis of set pieces of music.







### Entry Requirements..

Progression onto A Level Music will require at least 5 GCSEs, or equivalent, at grade C or above. It is essential that you can also play an instrument or can sing, have GCSE Music at grade C or above, and/or be studying ABRSM Music theory. Please talk to the Head of Department if you are interested in this subject.

Students must study at least 2 areas of study for AS and at least 3 areas of study at A Level. The range of set works is between 1650 and 1910.

Appraising Component 3	<ul> <li>40% of the total AS marks</li> <li>Knowledge and understanding of musical elements, contexts and language</li> <li>Application of knowledge of six areas of study, each with 3 set works</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>40% of the qualification</li> <li>Written examination: 2 hours</li> <li>Two sections A &amp; B</li> <li>Section A: Areas of study and dictation</li> <li>Section B: Extended response 2 essays in response to set works</li> </ul>
