

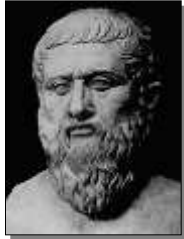

What challenges does Islam face in today's world?

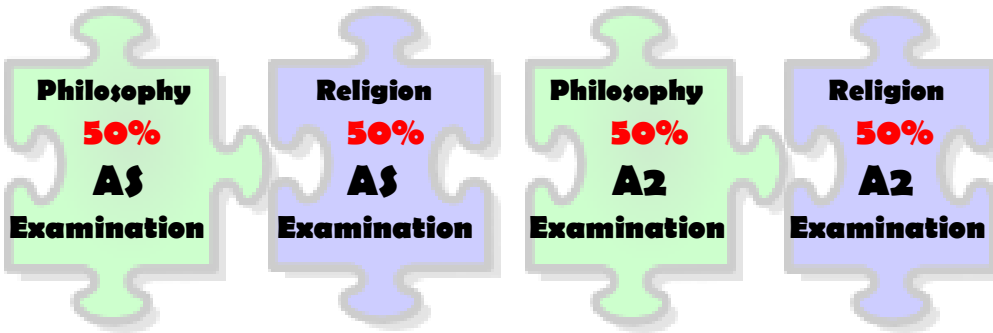

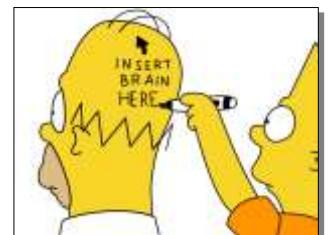
